**NEW LIFE LINE AMBULANCE STATION  
OPENS IN NORTH PRESCOTT VALLEY**

**PRESCOTT, Ariz.** – Life Line Ambulance, a private ambulance company serving Northern Arizona, has opened Station 22 in north Prescott Valley. The new station, the company's 10th in its service area, is located at 7975 Palo Verde St. and houses one ambulance, with room for an additional vehicle as call volumes increase.

“With all the growth in the north part of Prescott Valley, and with the new hospital there, Station 22's location is strategic and will allow us to provide more efficient delivery of service to the north side of Prescott Valley,” said Glenn Kasprzyk, Life Line Ambulance's chief operating officer. “This site also allows for future growth as the area becomes more built out and populated.”

The 4,000 square-foot, one -story building has crew quarters and two ambulance bays. The station provides 24-hour emergency services.

Life Line Ambulance is the largest ground ambulance service in northern Arizona. Established in 1956, the company services more than 8,500 square miles in Yavapai County, Coconino County and in the northwest corner of Maricopa County. This area covers both populated and rural areas. Life Line currently now has 10 strategically place stations and employs a staff of approximately 200, including paramedics, intermediate and basic emergency medical technicians and registered nurses, along with a support staff of professional dispatch, customer service, human resource, accounting and facilities/fleet maintenance personnel.
